## Q1. What experience have you had with Commonwealth disaster funding support?

Commonwealth funding is stifled in Queensland due to the additional layer to QRA. Queensland is the only state that have to pay a co-contribution (up to 50%) to secure the funding and may remote and regional Councils do not have the financial means for co-contribution.

By providing funding to Councils to employ a full time Local DMO - Local solutions to Local problems

Currently tied up in bureaucracy by QRA. Remote Councils are unwilling to apply due to this and the Cocontribution. QRRRF has to be different each round but this could be used to fund local DMO's with enhanced risk reduction and resilience programs.
